Ohrid as one of the oldest towns in Europe was the center of ancient civilization. It is where the first Slavic university in Europe was founded and it's also the town by the oldest lake.



Ohrid is notable for once having had 365 churches, one for each day of the year, and has been referred to as a "Jerusalem (of the Balkans)".

Ohrid town is first mentioned in Greek documents from 353 BCE, when it was known as Lychnidos or, "the city of light."
